Most accidents happen within the family home due to a number of reasons;




**Flyscreens are designed to keep flies and insects out; they were never designed to prevent kids from falling from windows.**

- ◆ Pushed by a sibling
- ◆ Sitting on a window sill, reading or looking out, or simply losing balance.

It is often impractical to keep windows permanently shut and constant parental supervision can be unrealistic. There are other things that can be done to give you peace of mind, when kids are playing in the house and out of sight.

The new Building Code Association (BCA) Window requirements state a window should not open more than 12.5cm, even if a flyscreen is fitted. Parents should keep furniture away from windows. If windows must be opened, parents should consider security screens that lock firmly into the window frame. Any fitted screen must be able to withstand 25kg of pressure in three different points.
